What are we doing?

From Monday 3 February for approximately four months, work will take place on Cranford Street starting from Innes Road, working towards Westminster Street. We will generally be working Mondays to Fridays, 7am to 7pm.

Our work includes the reconstruction of footpath and stormwater on Cranford Street, changes to the Malvern/Cranford and Dee/Cranford intersections, ducting installation, road reconstruction and the removal of some trees from Cranford Street.

Traffic impacts

Lane shifts and shoulder closures will be in place.

At times, there will be road closures on Dee Street and on Malvern Street at the Cranford Street intersections. We will let those in the area know when these road closures will occur.

We will need to restrict on-street parking, so will place no parking cones out before we start work. We will aim to minimise this as much as possible.

Please be on the lookout for changes in traffic management and follow the signs.

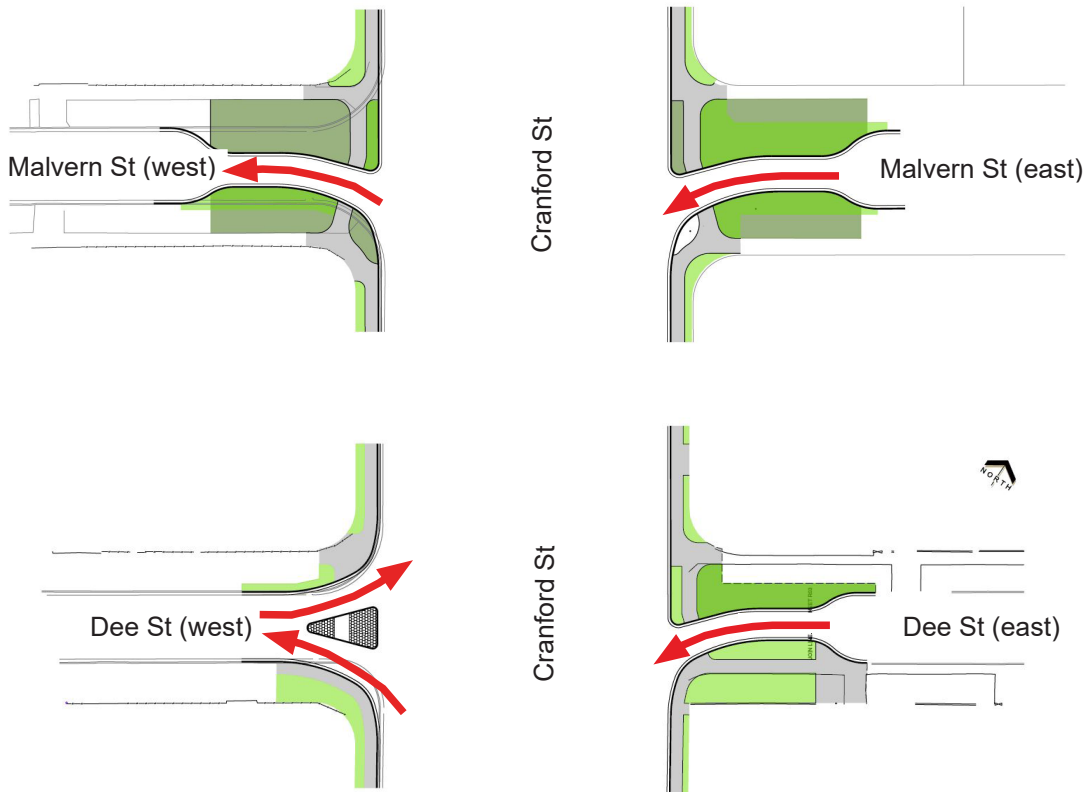
Pedestrians
