What are we doing?

We will be moving the Dee Street and Malvern Street road closures from the east side of Cranford Street to the west side to complete drainage works, as we have now completed drainage and some kerb and channel here.

Malvern Street (west of Cranford intersection) will be closed from Monday 9 March and Dee Street (west of Cranford intersection) will be closed from Wednesday 11 March. Both closures will be in place for approximately three weeks.

These road closures will return to the east side of Cranford Street following the completion of this work, then move back west again. We will notify those in the area prior. Once complete, there will be permanent turning restrictions in place into and out of Cranford Street.

Traffic impacts

The road will be closed on Dee Street (west of Cranford Street) and on Malvern Street (west of Cranford Street). Please be on the lookout for changes to traffic management and follow the signs.

Driveway access

We may need to work in front of driveways near these intersections from time to time. If we are working in front of your driveway, we will maintain your access with plates. We thank you for your patience and understanding.
