What are we doing?

From Monday 4 May for approximately four months, we will be making changes to the intersection of Warrington Street and Forfar Street. As a part of these changes, Forfar Street will be closed permanently on the north side of this intersection, which will become a three-leg intersection.

Works will be completed in three stages as per below. Most of our works will be carried out during the day, 7am - 7pm, however some night work may be required and we will notify those in the area prior to this.

Stage 1/3

We will be removing the roundabout and traffic islands, installing ducting and temporarily reinstating this area with asphalt. We will then start drainage and kerb and channel on the east side of the intersection. This will take approximately six weeks.

Stage 2/3

Drainage, footpath, and kerb and channel will be completed on the west side of the intersection.

Stage 3/3

We will complete works on the north side of the intersection. This will involve the permanent closure of Forfar Street on the north side of this intersection during this time.

We will then lay new pavement (road) across all sides of the intersection.

Access restrictions to your property

We will need to temporarily restrict access to some properties near to or at this intersection. We will door knock these properties or leave a notice in your mail box the day before we block access to give you time to move your car if needed.

Affected properties will have their access reinstated with plates until we complete the work in front of them. Pedestrian access to properties will be maintained at all times with the help of our friendly staff. We thank you for your patience and co-operation.

Traffic impacts

Lane shifts and shoulder closures will be in place. Please be on the lookout for changes in traffic management and follow the signs.

We hope you are staying safe and well during lockdown level three.
