What are we doing?

On Tuesday 26 May from approximately 3.30am to 8am, we expect to be carrying out footpath renewal works on the northwest side of Cranford Street / Westminster Street intersection. On Thursday 28 May from approximately 5.30am to 8am, we expect to be laying new asphalt for the footpath here.

Our work is subject to weather and may be carried out on mornings following if weather is unfavourable.

Night works

You will notice machinery, light and noise coming from the site while the crews are working.

We know night work is disruptive so we aim to complete this work as quickly as possible. Night work is required so we can maintain business access during the day. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

Traffic impacts

Pedestrian access will be maintained on the other side of Cranford Street during these works. The road closures on both sides of Westminster Street at Cranford Street intersection will remain.

Please be on the lookout for changes to the traffic management and follow the signs.
