- Edgeware Road will temporarily switch to one way - westbound from Manchester to Sherborne Street from Monday 15 June for approximately six weeks while we complete multiple tasks. Please follow signs and detours in place.
- Lane shifts will occur where required. This will mean that we will need to restrict road side parking outside some properties on Edgeware Road and Sherborne Street.
- Care should be taken when exiting driveways and when turning north or south onto Sherborne Street.
- We will keep you informed throughout the project with any updates or road traffic changes.
