What we are doing

You might have noticed we've been all go during Alert Level 3 – we were trying to do as much as possible (especially outside businesses) before the shift to Alert Level 2!

Shoulder (edge of road) work

We're digging up and rebuilding the western shoulders (edges of the road) between Winston Avenue and Langdons Road. This will take about two weeks.

Langdons Road intersection

We're finishing off installing the last of the new traffic pole foundations. We've poured the concrete for some of the new kerbs (gutters), and plan to finish these soon.

Road resurfacing

Once the shoulder work and the work at the Langdons Road intersection are complete, Council's maintenance team will re-surface

Main North Road between Winston Avenue and Langdons Road. This work will be carried out at night and will take several nights.

Please check your letterbox regularly; Council's roading contractor will deliver a notification of the work a few days before work begins.

Storm water work

We've removed the old asbestos pipe and installed the new pipe between the Langdons Road intersection and the north side of the southern mall entrance. We're working our way north towards the pedestrian crossing with new kerb and channel and footpath and expect this work will take up to another four weeks to complete.

Once this team finishes here, they'll move north to start the footpath and road re-alignment work on the west side of Main North Road beside Countdown.

Northlands (Countdown) entrance

We've started working at the Countdown entrance, and will be working here for about six weeks. Entry and exit traffic will be maintained at all times, except for some work which will be done after hours.

Grassmere Street

All of the work is finished at the Grassmere Street intersection, except the five new traffic poles (two on the Grassmere Street side and three on the Countdown side of Main North Road) and the footpath surface. Because of the number of underground services along Main North Road, the foundations for the new poles had to be redesigned and are currently being specially made.

We plan to open the entrance to Grassmere Street up to traffic by the 22nd May.
